
*fish*



### What size is best?


Location and size are the two most important decisions you'll make about your water feature. By some estimates, 90 percent of the original water gardens sold are replaced later with larger ones. An enthusiastic pond hobbyist always finds new plants or interesting fish to add to his/her investment. As a general rule, a 180 square-foot or 11' x 16' pond is a good "standard" size water feature. Trace your prospective pond out on the ground with a garden hose to help you visualize what the finished size will be.

### What is the cost?


A fully installed water feature is similarly priced to a hot tub. A well-designed water feature includes: mechanical and biological filtration, pump and plumbing, 45 mil EPDM liner and underlayment, a berm, underwater lighting, rock work, an automatic fill valve, and a waterfall. Your water garden requires **NO CHEMICALS, NO TEST KITS, FAR LESS MAINTENANCE, AND WILL ACTUALLY INCREASE YOUR PROPERTY VALUE!**



## The Aquascape Ecosystem



**SKIMMER**  
• Eliminates routine maintenance by removing debris before it sinks to the bottom of the pond, allowing pond construction anywhere, even beneath trees.  
• Hides the pump and plumbing from view alongside your pond instead of in the pond.  
• Won't drain the pond if a leak develops in the plumbing or waterfalls.

**PLANTS & PLANT POCKETS**  
• Helps hide unsightly lily containers.  
• Allows the roots to grow more abundantly and plants to bloom more freely, consuming excess nutrients and reducing debris in the pond.

**LINER**  
• Strong 45-mil EPDM liner is the best choice for most pond installations.  
• Easy and inexpensive to install and won't crack.

**UNDERLAYMENT**  
• A non-woven, needle punched underlayment forms a soft padding for the liner.  
• Unlike sand, carpet padding, and newspaper, it easily covers the vertical surfaces of the pond shelves.

**BIOFALLS® FILTER**  
• Creates a perfect base for building beautiful, leak-free waterfalls.  
• Simple, uncluttered design with no moving parts to break.  
• Built-in rock ledge allows this filter to be completely camouflaged.

**BACTERIA**  
• Products like AquaClearer™ Extreme bacteria help maintain clear and healthy water, and S.A.B.™ Extreme assists in the breakdown and reduction of debris in the pond.

**ROCKS & GRAVEL**  
• Adding rocks and gravel helps reduce pond maintenance by providing surface area for beneficial bacteria to colonize.  
• Covering the pond liner with gravel protects the liner from harmful UV rays and damage from animals and other sharp objects.  
• A stone bottom looks far more natural and is safer to walk on than an exposed, slippery rubber liner.
